

FORMAL INTERPRETATION No. 16-04

Subject: Labeling of Auxiliary Attachments or Room Additions
Reference: UAP, Part IV, Section 4(A)(1)(a), item 4
Effective Date: October 15, 2016

ISSUE

Many homes have one or more auxiliary attachments or room additions that vary greatly in size. Some have a single attachment that is less than 10 square feet while others may have as many as five with nearly 800 square feet of aggregate gross floor area. In accordance with UAP, Part IV, Section 4(A)(1)(a), item 4, both cases require one certification label. A room addition may also meet the definition of a module which is required to be labeled individually.

INTERPRETATION

The Commission has determined that the aggregate gross floor area of auxiliary attachments and room additions may not exceed 600 square feet per certification label. If the aggregate gross floor area is less than 50 square feet, a certification label is not required.
