Subject: Reporting of Unused Labels

Reference: Label Control Program

ISSUE: An examination of the Commission's label control records raised concerns regarding the status and location of a number of IBC certification labels. To reconcile its records, the Commission was forced to direct all inspection agencies and manufacturers to investigate and report on the current status of their certification labels. A more efficient method had to be established to verify the accuracy and completeness of the Commission's and inspection agencies' label control records.

INTERP.: On June 20, 1997, the Rules Development Committee recommended and the Commission approved a modification to the monthly production report. Until further notice, beginning with the August, 1997, monthly production reports, manufacturers must document the serial numbers of all IBC certification labels in their inventory. In accordance with Formal Interpretation 95-05, manufacturers are not required to submit monthly production reports if they do not have any unused certification labels.
